- Leaders must be specialists in all things Italian with fluency in the language (native or second language) and excellent cultural knowledge. They must also be a competent walking leader if applying to lead Walking the Amalfi Coast tour.
- Trips operate throughout the year, with the busiest season running from April to October, during which leaders typically work 2 - 4 weeks at a time.
- Leaders must be self-employed and be able to accept that work is dependent on tour departures being guaranteed.

- Leaders are often expected to work unsociable hours, so with this in mind, EU working hours would not apply.
