

COVID travel guide for Chile

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter mainland Chile you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID-19 test no more than 72 hours before departure 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is now accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For guidance on how to obtain this, please go here.</p> <p>Please note you must have your vaccination status validated by the Chilean authorities using an online platform. More information on this can be found below.</p> <p>This must be a PCR Test no more than 72 hours prior to boarding your flight to Santiago; if you are connecting, this must be taken no more than 72 hours before the time of your final flight.</p> <p>Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.</p> <p>Full information on these entry requirements can be found here.</p>
Before arrival you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit your vaccination certificate to be validated by the Chilean authorities and receive a 'Mobility Pass' Complete an Affidavit 	<p>The validation can be done online and can be found here. Please note this can take up to 30 days to be processed. Once approved, you will receive a QR Code; please retain this as you may be asked to show this when travelling within Chile.</p> <p>The Affidavit can be accessed here. This can be completed up to 48 hours before boarding. Upon completion you will receive a separate QR code sent by email separately.</p> <p>While in Chile the Health Authorities may require you to complete a daily 'self-report' for up to 10 days via an online form. The details of this will be provided to you by email.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take a second COVID test Show evidence of your vaccination status and negative test result Show your QR code confirming you have completed the Affidavit 	<p>This will be either a PCR or lateral flow test, and costs approximately US\$40. After taking the test you will transfer to your hotel where you will need to quarantine until you receive a negative result, which is estimated to take between 6 and 12 hours.</p> <p>Please ensure you have the correct evidence/certificates with you before you depart.</p>

IF YOU ARE TRAVELLING TO CHILE VIA THE UNITED STATES
You will need to show:

- That you are fully vaccinated against COVID
- AND**
- That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 24 hours before travel, OR that you have recovered from COVID no more than 90 days prior to the flight.

The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted; you must have completed your course of vaccination at least 14 days before departure.

This can be a PCR or lateral flow test, taken no more than 24 hours before departure.

For your return journey, a COVID test can be taken in Chile towards the end of your trip. This will be arranged by our local team.

72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your PCR test for entry into Chile <input type="checkbox"/> Complete the Affidavit and save the resultant QR code

24 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If travelling via the US, take your COVID test

BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:
FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK
Time before travel

72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check here .
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link here) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your test for transit via the US
On departure	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
Return home	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
