

COVID travel guide for Egypt

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter the country you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID-19 test 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is now accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For guidance on how to obtain your Pass please go here.</p> <p>This must be a PCR Test taken within 72 hours prior to departure, unless arriving from London Heathrow only, in which case the test must be conducted no more than 96 hours before departure. In order to be valid, the negative test certificate will need to show a stamp from the testing company or a QR code. More information on this can be found here. Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider.</p> <p>For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.</p>
Before arrival you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fill out a health declaration form 	<p>This form can be accessed here.</p> <p>Please print and complete the form prior to departure, and have it with you throughout your journey to Egypt.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Present your completed health declaration form Show evidence of your vaccination status or negative test result Provide confirmation of valid travel insurance You may also be required to undertake a lateral flow test 	<p>Please ensure you have the correct documents with you before you depart.</p> <p>Please make sure that you have adequate and valid travel insurance for your entire stay in Egypt. For information on the Exodus travel insurance policy, please visit this page of our website.</p> <p>If you are asked to undergo a test and return a positive result, you will be required to take a subsequent PCR test. If a positive diagnosis is confirmed, you will need to follow local laws on self-isolation.</p>

10 days	<input type="checkbox"/> If not fully vaccinated, book your PCR test for entry into Egypt <input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check here .. <input type="checkbox"/> If fully vaccinated, obtain your NHS COVID Pass for Travel
96 / 72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If not fully vaccinated, take your PCR test for entry into Egypt (96 hours if flying to Egypt from London Heathrow, 72 hours if travelling from any other airport)
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Print and complete your health declaration form <input type="checkbox"/> Download/print your travel insurance documents (policy document and insurance certificate) <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. Please note that the Egyptian authorities may not accept results from self-testing kits purchased in the UK and taken on the trip. We advise taking a test locally, which will be arranged by our team in Egypt.
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link here) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
On departure	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
Return home	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
