

## COVID travel guide for Greece

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>To enter the country, you will need to show that you are:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Full vaccination against COVID</li> </ul> <b>OR</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 72 hours before arrival.</li> </ul>	<p>The NHS COVID Pass is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status. More details on this can be found <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>This can be a PCR Test taken within 72 hours of travel, <b>or</b> rapid antigen test undertaken within 48 hours of travel. Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider.</p> <p>For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to <a href="#">this guide</a>.</p>
<b>Before arrival you will need to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete a Passenger Locator Form to register with the Greek authorities</li> </ul>	The entry form can be completed in advance by going <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>Upon arrival you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of your vaccination record or negative PCR test</li> <li>Present your completed Passenger Locator Form</li> </ul>	<p>Please ensure you have the correct certificates with you and have completed your Passenger Locator Form before you depart.</p> <p>Upon completing the Passenger Locator Form you will be sent an email containing a QR Code, which will be scanned by immigration officials.</p>
<b>While in Greece you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of full vaccination OR having received a recent negative COVID test to be permitted entry into some restaurants/bars/public venues</li> </ul>	<p>Your NHS COVID Pass for Travel will be accepted as evidence for these. We advise having a PDF copy of this on your phone/device, and a printed copy with you throughout the trip for this purpose.</p> <p>If you have not been fully vaccinated please contact our Customer Operations team at your earliest opportunity to discuss what options may be open to you.</p>

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>Time before departure</b>	
<b>14 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Reconfirm your destination entry requirements
<b>10 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your Passenger Locator Form for entry into Greece
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Download and print your COVID Pass from the NHS App, <b>or</b> take your PCR Test for entry into Greece (if not fully vaccinated)
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

**BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:**

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link <a href="#">here</a> ) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
<b>On departure</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
<b>Return home</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
