

COVID travel guide for Italy

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter the country you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 48 hours before arrival. 	<p>Further information on these requirements can be found here.</p> <p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status; to find out how to obtain this please go here.</p> <p>This can be either a PCR or rapid flow test. Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.</p>
Before arrival you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete an online EU Passenger Locator Form 	<p>This is done online here.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Need to present document confirming you are fully vaccinated AND showing your negative COVID test result Show that you have completed the Passenger Locator Form 	<p>When you complete the Passenger Locator Form a QR code will be generated; expect to show this when checking in for your flight and at Italian border control</p>
After arrival you must:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call the COVID-19 Helpline in the region you are visiting to inform them of your visit 	<p>This must be done within 48 hours of arrival. More information is available here. Your Exodus tour leader will be able to assist with this.</p>
While in Italy you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show evidence of full vaccination OR having received a recent negative COVID test to be permitted entry into some restaurants/bars/public venues and on some forms of public transport 	<p>Your NHS COVID Pass for Travel will be accepted as evidence for these. We advise having a PDF copy of this on your phone/device, and a printed copy with you throughout the trip for this purpose.</p> <p>If you have not been fully vaccinated please contact our Customer Operations team at your earliest opportunity to discuss what options may be open to you.</p>

14 days	<input type="checkbox"/> Reconfirm your destination entry requirements & obtain your COVID Pass (in both PDF and printer version)
10 days	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check here ..
72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your EU Passenger Locator Form
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test for entry into Italy
~24 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check here .
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link here) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
On departure	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
Return home	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
