

## COVID travel guide for Italy

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>To enter the country you will need to show:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you are fully vaccinated against COVID</li> </ul> <p><b>AND</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 48 hours before arrival.</li> </ul>	<p>Further information on these requirements can be found <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status; to find out how to obtain this please go <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>This can be either a PCR test taken no more than 48 hours before entering Italy or rapid flow test taken no more than 24 hours before entering Italy. Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to <a href="#">this guide</a>.</p>
<b>Before arrival you will need to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete an online EU Passenger Locator Form</li> </ul>	<p>This is done online <a href="#">here</a>.</p>
<b>Upon arrival you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Need to present document confirming you are fully vaccinated <b>AND</b> showing your negative COVID test result</li> <li>Show that you have completed the Passenger Locator Form</li> </ul>	<p>When you complete the Passenger Locator Form a QR code will be generated; expect to show this when checking in for your flight and at Italian border control</p>
<b>After arrival you must:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Call the COVID-19 Helpline in the region you are visiting to inform them of your visit</li> </ul>	<p>This must be done within 48 hours of arrival. More information is available <a href="#">here</a>. Your Exodus tour leader will be able to assist with this.</p>
<b>While in Italy you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of full vaccination OR having received a recent negative COVID test to be permitted entry into some restaurants/bars/public venues and on some forms of public transport</li> <li>Need to wear a FFP2 face covering when using public transport</li> </ul>	<p>Your NHS COVID Pass for Travel will be accepted as evidence for these. We advise having a PDF copy of this on your phone/device, and a printed copy with you throughout the trip for this purpose.</p> <p>If you have not been fully vaccinated please contact our Customer Operations team at your earliest opportunity to discuss what options may be open to you.</p> <p>FFP2 face coverings differ from the cloth/surgical types generally used in the UK. They are available to purchase online or in most high-street pharmacies.</p>

<b>14 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Reconfirm your destination entry requirements & obtain your COVID Pass (in both PDF and printer version)
<b>10 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> ..
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your EU Passenger Locator Form
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test for entry into Italy if you are taking a PCR test.
<b>24 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test for entry into Italy if you are taking a rapid flow test.
<b>~24 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

## BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link <a href="#">here</a> ) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
<b>On departure</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
<b>Return home</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
