

## COVID travel guide for Kenya

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>To enter the country you will need to show:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 96 hours before arrival.</li> </ul>	<p>Further information on these requirements can be found <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to <a href="#">this guide</a>.</p>
<b>Before arrival you will need to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete an online COVID-19 Travellers Health Surveillance Form</li> <li>Upload your test result to the Kenyan government's Trust Traveller service</li> </ul>	<p>The Form is completed online <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>The test is uploaded <a href="#">here</a>. We understand that the Trusted Traveller website can be unreliable; if you have issued uploading your result please contact us for assistance.</p>
<b>Upon arrival you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show your negative test result</li> <li>Show that you have completed the Health Surveillance Form</li> </ul>	<p>Upon completion of the Health Surveillance Form, you will be provided with a QR code. Please save this and print a copy as it will be scanned on entry into Kenya. Please retain this, as you will be asked to show it again when departing Kenya after your trip.</p> <p>While in Kenya you may be contacted by email and asked to resubmit information to update the Health Surveillance Form. If this does happen please speak to your tour leader for guidance.</p>

### BEFORE YOU LEAVE CHECKLIST:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>Time before departure</b>	
<b>14 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Reconfirm your destination entry requirements
<b>10 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your PCR test for entry into Kenya, and your PCR test(s) to be taken when you return home (if applicable)
<b>96 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your PCR test for entry into Kenya
<b>24 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your Health Surveillance form, upload your test result, and save and print the resultant QR code
<b>24 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

## BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> <input type="checkbox"/> If you require a PCR Test prior to departing Kenya, this can be arranged locally; please check your onward travel requirements and if necessary speak to your tour leader, who will be able to assist with arranging this.
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link <a href="#">here</a> )
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
<b>At time of departure</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Expect to be asked to show your Health Surveillance Form QR Code
<b>Return home</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Show your entry documents to UK immigration <input type="checkbox"/> Take your PCR test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status)
