

# COVID travel guide for mainland Portugal

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>To enter the country you will need to show:</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ol> <b>OR</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you have received a negative COVID-19 test no more than 72 hours before arrival.</li> </ol>	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is now accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information please click <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>If you are not fully vaccinated, either a PCR Test taken within <b>72 hours</b> of travel, <b>OR</b> a lateral flow/antigen test taken within <b>48 hours</b> of travel are accepted. Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider. <b>Before arrival you will need to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fill out a Passenger Locator Card to register with the Portuguese authorities.</li> </ul>	<p>The Passenger Locator Card can be completed by going <a href="#">here</a></p>
<b>Upon arrival you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of your vaccination status or negative test result</li> <li>Undergo a temperature check.</li> </ul>	<p>Please ensure you have the correct evidence/certificates with you before you depart.</p> <p>If your temperature is 38°C or over, or if you show symptoms of being unwell, you may be required to take a COVID-19 test and remain at the airport until the test results are received.</p>
<b>While in Portugal you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of full vaccination <b>OR</b> having received a recent negative COVID-19 test to check into some accommodation, and be permitted entry into some restaurants/bars or other public venues/events</li> </ul>	<p>Your <b>NHS COVID Pass for Travel</b> will be accepted as evidence for these. We advise having a PDF copy of this on your phone/device, and a printed copy with you throughout the trip for this purpose. For guidance on how to obtain your Pass please go <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>You will need to show that you have been fully vaccinated at least 14 days prior to travel. Full information from the Portuguese authorities can be found <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>If you have not been fully vaccinated please contact our Customer Operations team at your earliest opportunity to discuss what options may be open to you.</p>

<b>14 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Reconfirm your destination entry requirements
<b>10 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If required, book your COVID-19 test for entry into Portugal (PCR or lateral flow) <input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> ..
<b>10 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Obtain your NHS COVID Pass for Travel, in both PDF and printed format
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your Passenger Locator Card for Portugal
	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

**BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:**

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link <a href="#">here</a> ) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
<b>On departure</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
<b>Return home</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
