

COVID travel guide for Peru

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter the country you will need to show that:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID vaccination status. For more information please click here.</p> <p>It is possible to enter Peru if you are not fully vaccinated, by providing evidence of a negative COVID test prior to travel. There are, however, restrictions on what you are able to do while in Peru if you are not fully vaccinated. You will also need to show evidence of vaccination to enter the airport upon departure.</p> <p>We are therefore only able to accept individuals who are fully vaccinated on Exodus trips in Peru</p>
Before arrival you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete an affidavit for the Peruvian authorities 	<p>This is done online by going here.</p> <p>The online form will ask for various details about your stay in Peru; for these please refer to your Final Joining Instructions.</p> <p>If you require further assistance please contact our Customer Operations Team.</p>
Upon arrival you may be asked to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Present your completed online affidavit form 	<p>Please download the completed form upon completion, and have it readily available throughout your journey, should you be asked to show this by airline staff and/or immigration officials. We recommend having a digital and printed copy.</p>
Whilst in Peru you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show evidence of full vaccination to be permitted entry into some restaurants/bars/public venues and on some forms of public transport (including internal flights) 	<p>Your NHS COVID Pass for Travel will be accepted as evidence for these. We advise having a PDF copy of this on your phone/device, and a printed copy with you throughout the trip for this purpose.</p>

<i>Time before travel</i>	
72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test.
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link here) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form <input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
On departure	<input type="checkbox"/> Show evidence of vaccination when entering the airport <input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
Return home	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
