

## COVID travel guide for Morocco

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<b>To enter the country you will need to show:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you are fully vaccinated against COVID</li> </ul> <p><b>AND</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That you have received a negative COVID test result before arrival</li> </ul>	<p>The second dose of vaccine must have been administered at least two weeks prior to travel. The NHS COVID Pass is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status. More details on this can be found <a href="#">here</a></p> <p>This must be PCR Test, taken no more than 48 hours before boarding your flight. Free NHS tests are not accepted; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to <a href="#">this guide</a></p>
<b>Before arrival you will need to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete a Public Health Passenger Form</li> </ul>	<p>The form can be completed by going <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>Please note this form must be printed after completion, and a paper copy taken with you when you travel.</p>
<b>During your journey you will be asked to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of your vaccination status and negative PCR test</li> <li>Present your completed entry form</li> </ul>	<p>Please ensure you have the correct documents readily available, and have printed the entry form before you depart.</p>
<b>While in Morocco you will:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of full vaccination to check into some accommodation, and be permitted entry into some restaurants/bars or other public venues/events</li> </ul>	<p>Your <b>NHS COVID Pass for Travel</b> will be accepted as evidence for these. We advise having a PDF copy of this on your phone/device, and a printed copy with you throughout the trip for this purpose. For guidance on how to obtain your Pass please go <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>If you have not been fully vaccinated please contact our Customer Operations team at your earliest opportunity to discuss what options may be open to you.</p>

<b>14 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Reconfirm your destination entry requirements
<b>10 days</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your PCR test for entry into Morocco
	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> ..
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your PCR test for entry into Morocco

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
<b>72 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>48 hours</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link <a href="#">here</a> )
	<input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form
	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
<b>On departure</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
<b>Return home</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
