

COVID travel guide for Morocco

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK			
To enter Morocco you will need to show:			
• OR	That you are fully vaccinated against COVID (including booster)	The last dose of vaccine must have been administered at least two weeks prior to travel. The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status. More details on this can be found here.	
•	That you have received a negative COVID test result before arrival	This must be PCR Test, taken no more than 48 hours before boarding your flight; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.	
Before arrival you will need to:			
•	Complete a Public Health Passenger Form	The form can be completed by going here.	
		Please note this form must be printed after completion, and a paper copy taken with you when you travel.	
Upon arrival you will:			
•	Show evidence that you are fully vaccinated	Please ensure you have obtained your NHS COVID Pass before you depart.	
or •	Show evidence of your negative COVID test	Please ensure you have the correct document with you before travelling.	
AN •	D Be prepared to show your completed health declaration form	You can either print the health declaration form and fill it in on paper, or you can complete it digitally on your mobile phone or tablet.
